

## **leaning the setting during Covid:**

### **General cleaning**

Clean and disinfect surfaces that are touched regularly using standard cleaning products - where possible, using soapy water.

Bag waste at the end of the day and dispose of as usual.

### **Thorough cleaning (if there is a suspected case of COVID-19 in the setting)**

Wear a minimum of an apron and gloves to clean

Use warm, soapy water and disinfectant

Use disposable cloths.

Disinfect any surfaces or areas where the person may have had contact including bathrooms, door handles, table tops. Pay particular attention to frequently touched areas.

Double-bag all of the disposables and setting them aside securely **(72 hours)** before putting them into the general waste

Wash hands and forearms in warm soapy water

### **Daily routine:**

**Fixtures and fittings:** eg light switches, door knobs: to be cleaned regularly throughout the day.

**Toilet area:** Toilet seats, taps in toilets, hand driers, soap dispensers to be cleaned frequently by a member of staff, wearing gloves and aprons. Use disposable cloths.

**Tables, chairs and mats:** To be wiped down using warm soapy water after each session.

**Toys and play equipment (both inside and outside):** thoroughly cleaned in warm soapy water and Milton the end of each session or anti-bac spray if they are not water-resistant (such as books)

**Ipads and phone:** to be wiped down immediately after use by the last user.

**Floors:** to be immediately cleaned using disinfectant and detergent if there are any spillages during the day (using PPE if in toilet or bodily fluids elsewhere). Toilet floor to be cleaned with detergent and disinfectant at the end of each day.
