Spread of covid-19	Children & their families Staff	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limit number of children coming to nursery (MANAGERS) • Use of different access, via 'committee room' to minimize risk of parents passing each other & to keep personal effects separate (ALL) • Only one parent to bring child to nursery (MANAGERS) • No admittance to any parent/sibling into the nursery (MANAGERS) • 2m lines drawn to keep people apart as they arrive & queue to enter building (MANAGERS) • Notice and pre-notification to families for children: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - not to attend nursery if have cough/cold; - if they have a temperature; - if they have been given calpol; - if anyone else in the family is ill (MANAGERS/ALL) • Children to use alcohol based hand sanitizer immediately as they enter the building (ALL) • Signing in to be done by staff (ALL) • Coats, wellies, change of clothes to be kept in committee room (ALL) • Children to take trays, with their lunchboxes, waterbottles, sunscreen and sunhats only, into the main hall. (ALL) • Once they have placed their trays, they will then go to wash their hands, with supervision of adult. (ALL)
