Spread of covid-19	Children & their families Staff	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limit of number of children at nursery (MANAGERS)</li> <li>• Use of different access, via 'committee room' to minimize risk of people passing each other &amp; to keep personal effects separate (ALL)</li> <li>• Only one parent to collect child from nursery (MANAGERS)</li> <li>• No admittance to any parent/sibling into the nursery (MANAGERS)</li> <li>• Children will stay in the main hall until their parents arrive (ALL)</li> <li>• Once parents arrive, the children will collect their trays and then come through to the committee room, to collect their coats, clothes etc.</li> <li>• Children will wash their hands immediately before they leave (ALL)</li> <li>• 2m lines clearly marked to keep people apart as they queue to collect their child.</li> <li>• Clearly defined 'path' to allow child and parent to stay at least 2m away from other parents waiting to collect their child.</li> <li>• Parents reminded not to congregate around the area, as necessary</li> </ul>
